## RACE INSTRUCTIONS

*All competitors must fill in an entry form, sign disclaimer and return it by June 9th with the £15 fee.*

Firstly thanks for entering this fun event. We are using a lunch time gap in the proceedings of this year's Town Centre Cycle Race while the Avenue is closed and barriered off, care of British Cycling. We have 30 minutes to complete the race, it must therefore run as smoothly as possible. This first year we have limited it to 20 barrows. All competitors must register and pick up numbers at the Hobby Horse car park by 12 noon, half an hour before the start. All numbers must be fixed to front of costumes.

Each barrow will be marked against: 1) best time, 2) Fancy Dress, 3) Money raised for charity (to be announced) and 4) Least beer spillage! (not easy with half a yard of ale at 2nd stop). PLEASE NOTE: *NO NUMBERS WILL BE HANDED OUT AFTER 12 NOON AND COMPETITORS WILL NOT BE REFUNDED.*

The barrows will start at the junction of North Road and Blenheim Road, so after affixing numbers competitors should make their way along the seafront into Blenheim Road and gather on the pavement or grass area on the corner at 12.15.

Barrows will be set off in pairs accurately timed, 1 and 2 first followed by 3 and 4 at 30 second intervals so as to avoid congestion and possible collisions.

The race starts at 12.30 and proceeds up the Avenue, U-turn at Bancks Street and finishes just in Blenheim Road with drink stations at Stones and Bar 21 (see map on reverse).
